Women on the Border: Maryland Perspectives of the Civil War Exhibit Tours.

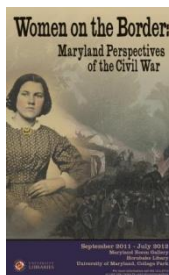
