Getting to Union Station:

1. Take the shuttle bus, or the Metro (public) bus (i.e. C8, F6, J4 lines), near the Marriott to the **COLLEGE PARK** Station.
2. Once you arrive at the station, use a fare machine to purchase a fare card. How much will it cost? Refer to the large map of the Metro System, posted near the fare card machines, to determine the trip fare to **UNION** Station. Add enough \$ for a round trip.
3. Enter your fare card as you go through the turnstile. Keep track of your fare card as you will need it to exit the Metro system!
4. Take the escalator to the train platform. You are on the **GREEN LINE**. Take the train in the direction of **BRANCH AVENUE** Station.
5. Go **3** stops and get off at the **FORT TOTTEN** Station.
6. Follow the signs to the **RED LINE**. Take the **RED LINE** train in the direction of **SHADY GROVE** Station. Go **4** stops and get off at **UNION** Station.
7. Exit by following the signs to the Union Station or Massachusetts Avenue exits (*see location of exits on the next page*).
