

RECORD GROUP IV. ORAL HISTORIES

Record Group Description

Record Group IV contains recordings and transcripts of oral histories. Interviewees and interviewers are all MLA members, both living and deceased. Formats include compact discs, cassette tapes, paper transcripts of interviews, and release documents related to the interviews. The MLA Oral History Committee oversees national level projects and interview methodology, and also provides guidance for MLA chapter oral history projects. The first MLA Oral Histories were conducted by Carol June Bradley from 1985 – 1988 for use in her many articles and books.

Extent: 58 compact discs, 50 cassette tapes, 0.6 linear feet of interview transcripts and release documents.
