

HOW TO ASSEMBLE YOUR PASSPORT

*Start your journey through the UMD
Libraries with these easy steps!*



1. **Print your passport.** Make sure to select “full size” in the printing options so that your passport comes out right.
2. **Fold** your page in half the long way (hot dog style), unfold, fold the short way (hamburger style), then fold the long way again to create a smaller hot dog style fold. You will have made creases along each of the blue lines.
3. **Cut.** Unfold once, then cut along the dotted line, down the middle from the folded edge to the next crease.
4. **Unfold,** then repeat the first hot dog fold again. Press both ends together, then press flat. Fold in half one more time to create the eight pages, and ensure the cover is on the outside.
5. **Ta-da!** You’re ready to go get your passport stamped at all 6 UMD Libraries branches. Bon voyage!

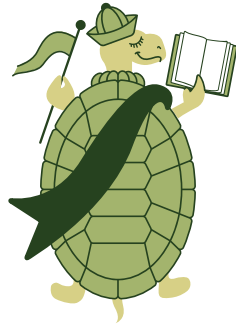
